The Danube River flows into the Black Sea within my country's territory forming the Danube Delta, the second largest and best preserved delta in Europe. The Danube delta hosts over 300 species of birds and 45 freshwater fish species in its numerous lakes.

My country has one of the largest areas of undisturbed forest in Europe in the famous Carpathian Mountains. Here you will find almost 400 unique species of mammals, birds, reptiles and amphibians, and most of Europe's brown bears and wolves. My country is also famous for the legend of Count Dracula whose remote castle is situated in the Carpathian Mountains. The spine-chilling tale of Dracula was inspired by the 15 th century Count Vlad Dracul.
